2. Introduction and Objectives

The “**Nicaragua Exporta**” Forum is a platform of the Government of Reconciliation and National Unity aimed at promoting Nicaragua’s exportable supply, bringing together producers, exporters, investors, international buyers, and representatives of public and private institutions, with the purpose of generating business opportunities, facilitating the establishment of strategic partnerships, and consolidating commercial relations, while promoting the competitiveness and socioeconomic development of our people.

The objectives of the Forum are:

- Promote the increase in exports and the search for new markets through a commercial exchange space that facilitates coordination among participants.
- Promote investment in strategic sectors that contribute to productivity, value addition, and the expansion and diversification of our exportable supply.
- Strengthen participants’ capacities in productive and commercial matters.

3. Event Organization

The “Nicaragua Exporta” Forum is an annual event organized by MIFIC, in coordination with SPIEX and CNZF. This platform has an international reach to promote our export offerings

3.2. Activities

The main activities that will take place during the event are:

- a. Trade exhibition (products and services)
- b. Coffee tasting and Brewing demonstrations
- c. Business networking sessions
- d. Conferences and specialized panels
- e. Technical advisory for exporters from the public sector

4. Participation Modalities

The “**Nicaragua Exporta**” Forum offers different participation modalities designed to address the objectives and interests of companies, institutions, and other stakeholders linked to foreign trade. Each modality includes specific benefits that allow participants to access training spaces, commercial promotion, business networking opportunities, and technical support.

a. **Commercial Exhibitor:**

Under this modality, **exporters of goods and service providers** may access an exhibition space (booth) to present and promote their offerings to buyers, investors, and other Forum participants. They may also participate in specialized conferences and panels, as well as receive technical assistance from institutions linked to foreign trade to strengthen their internationalization strategy.

b. **Delegate:**

Under this modality, **members of the diplomatic corps or regional or international organizations, panelists, moderators, speakers, and Government officials** may participate in the Forum’s conferences, specialized panels, and commercial exhibition area.

c. **International Buyer:**

Under this modality, **international buyers** may participate in the conferences, specialized panels, commercial exhibition area, and business matchmaking meetings.

4.1 Participant Registration

Participant registration for the “Nicaragua Exporta” Forum will be carried out through the website: <https://nicaraguaexporta.mific.gob.ni/>

Note: All participation modalities must complete online registration.

The participation fee as a commercial exhibitor during the Forum is C\$12,000.00, which includes the assignment of one (1) booth, accreditation, and meals for three (3) people per participant. The cost for each additional person will be C\$1,850.00.

The booth consists of a standard basic setup measuring 3 x 2 meters (6 square meters), in accordance with the event's graphic line, including a fascia with the exhibitor's name, one table, two chairs, and two electrical outlets.

The design, graphic line, and booth layout will be adjusted according to the concept approved by the Organizing Committee.



5. Registration Payment

Once the participation confirmation email sent by the Organizing Committee has been received, the participant must make the payment of the participation fee, as follows:

- a. Register in the Auxiliary Entry Control System "SACI" <https://gestion.mific.gob.ni/>
- b. Generate payment order.
- c. Make payment via electronic transfer or deposit into the TGR-MIFIC account.
- d. Charge the payment or transfer baucher to the SACI.
- e. Generation of the proof of payment in the SACI.
